Training – Protection Officers



- 8-week training program from start date to release from field training
 - Policy & Procedures
 - STORM (Strategy & Tactics for Redirecting Movement) & GST (Gracie Survival Tactics
 - CIT (Crisis Intervention Techniques)
 - VDI (Verbal Defense & Influence)
 - Tools of Law Enforcement
 - Taser 7, Axon 3 BWC, Handcuffs, REPULs chemical irritant

Training – Dispatchers



- 8-week training program from start date to release from field training
- Policy & Procedure
- Shadow
 - Normally 5 or 6 days
- Alert(s) training
 - Fire
 - Medical
 - Stroke
 - RRT
 - Missing/Abducted child
 - Elopement
- Field Training "Left seat/Right Seat"



Training – Dispatchers



- ReportExec
 - System used to generate and track reports/calls for service
- Milestone Camera System
 - Locations
 - Monitor officer safety
- Mitel Phone System
- Final test of all skills at end of 8th week



Training – Hospital Staff



- Unit Specific Active Threat Planning
 - Green Dot initiative
- Active shooter training
 - HCSO presence
- De-escalation training
- Basic self-defense training



Alert System – Alertus



- Controlled by Security Operations Center (SOC)
- Active shooter
- Missing/Abducted child
- Security alerts internal/external
- Fire Alerts



Alert System – Telmediq



- Improved version of a pager/paging system triggered by the SOC
 - Usually accompanies an Alertus page
- Medical emergencies
 - Telmediq page to medical team
- Security Alert Internal/External
 - Telmediq page to security supervisors & duty sergeant



Challenges



- Access Control
 - EZ Lobby pass system
- Hiring Lack of qualified applicants
- System wide training
 - Verbal De-Escalation
 - Basic Self-defense



Future Improvement Plans – Officers



Access Control

- Only 5 access points
- Turnstiles at access points
 - Badge access or controlled by officers/staff

Hiring Officers

- Approved for nearly a 30% increase in FTEs in 2024
- Hiring increased for officers and dispatchers



Future Improvement Plans – Dispatch



Hiring dispatchers

- 3rd dispatcher on 24/7
- Also assists with surveillance
